New Eagle Rank Extension Process

- The Scout Executive has the authority to grant a limited time extension (up to six months) to a Scout.
- Requests must:
 - (a) explain why or how the circumstances necessitate an extension,
 - (b) indicate the number of months believed to be necessary to complete the requirements,
 - (c) explain how that period of time was determined, and
 - (d) include documentation of the circumstances.

Eagle Scout Required Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Merit Badge

- The introduction of the proposed Diversity, Equity and Inclusion merit badge is being delayed.
