- Specific features available are determined by your role in Scouting
- Look for “Roster” on the menu. That’s where you can produce:
  - rosters
  - reports (Unit Pin, Record of Change, Membership Totals, Eagle Extension)
- Online Registration
  - Access to tools that support membership growth
  - Find information on BeAScout (used to promote a unit)
- Invitation Manager
  - Identifies interested families and supports extending invitations to them
- Application Manager
  - Enables unit leaders to act quickly on online applications

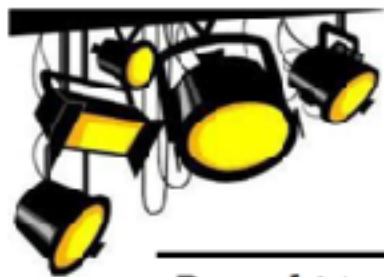

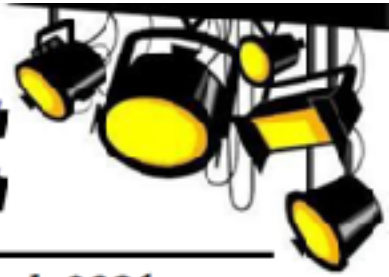
BSA's premiere Adult Leadership Training

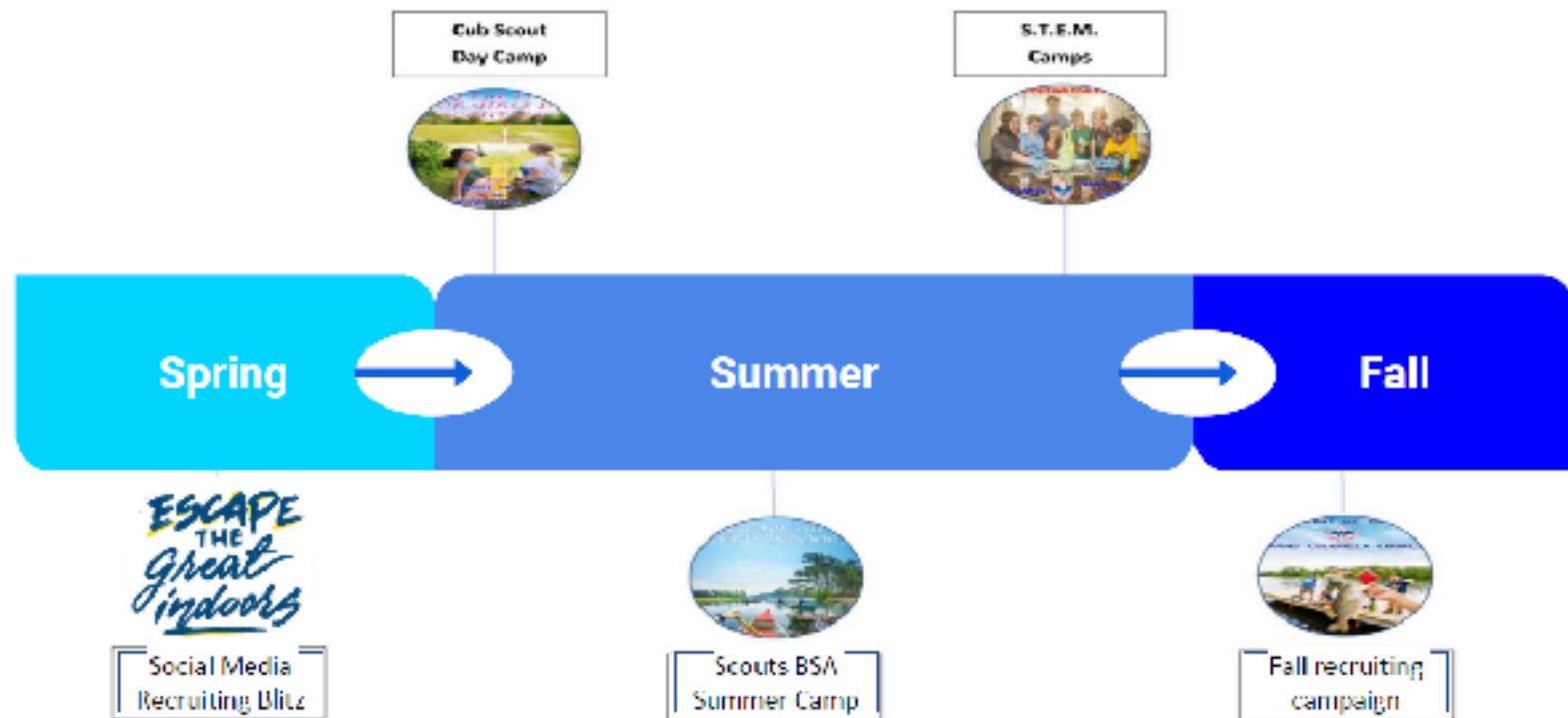
# Twin Valley - Geocaching

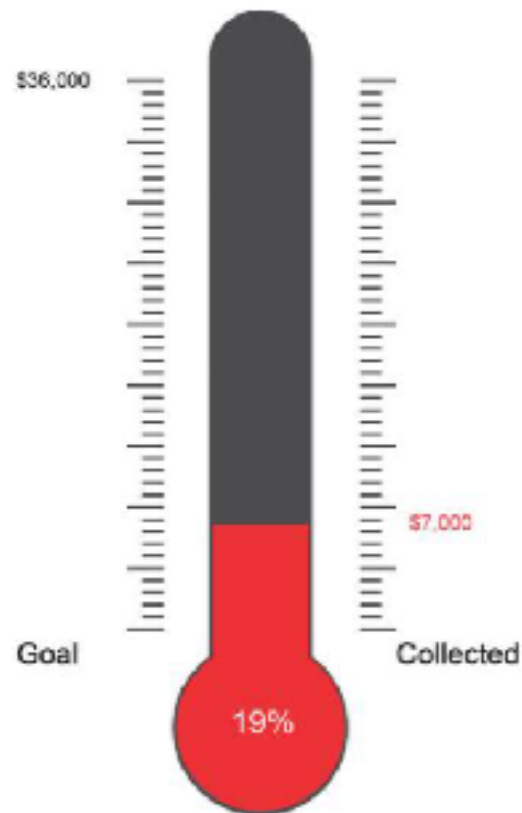

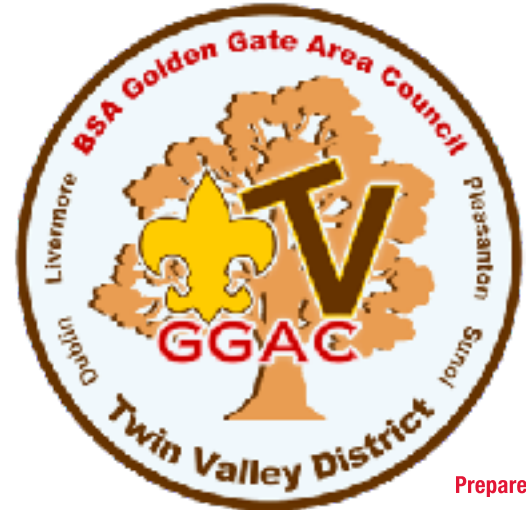
